For types of foundation work not set out in the above scale, actual costs plus the customary supervision of 15% will be levied. Where the nature of the ground is such that additional piers for support are necessary, the actual cost will be charged.

14. Cremations. Our cremation fees include the disposal of cremated remains packed for collection or scattered or buried in the Garden of Remembrance. They also include a cremation certificate. If the deceased is a life member of the Cremation Society of Great Britain or the Cremation Assurance Friendly Society, the fee will be recovered from the society.

15. The Saturday and public holiday levy is an additional charge, on top of the standard burial / cremation charge

16. In the case of double occupancy, where the lease term of the first occupancy expires, the first urn will remain in the niche until the lease for the second urn expires.

17. Copies of Book of Remembrance entries can be obtained at 50% of current charge

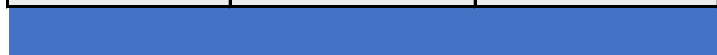

Crematorium Charges

Scale of Charges: effective from 1 April 2024

The cremation fee includes up to 45 minutes service time, Medical Referee's fee, biodegradable urn, certificate of cremation, choice of a maximum of four songs from the Obitus music system and a single photo uploaded to eulogy screen, if desired.

Unattended cremation is an unattended service with no mourners present and can only be booked through the office dependent upon availability.

* Proof of residency within Antrim and Newtownabbey Borough must be provided to claim resident fee. Resident status can be claimed if person can prove residency in the Borough in the preceding 7 years of any transaction; For more information, visit; antrimandnewtownabbey.gov.uk/resident-status

Test Dig

Test Dig – (payment / refund) when a test dig has been requested, the fee should be paid up front. Once complete and if found the burial can proceed, the test dig fee paid should be deducted from any burial opening fee due to be paid.
